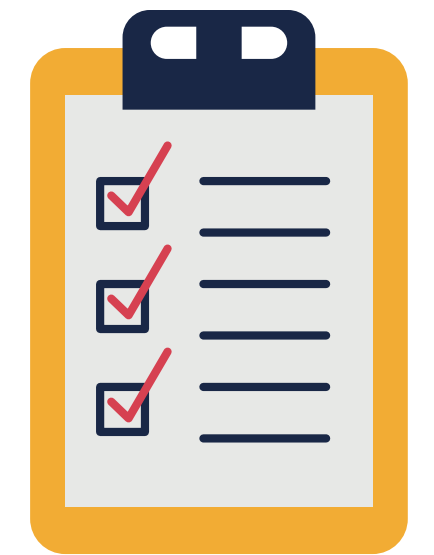


AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Air Quality Management Plan, or AQMP?

The AQMP is an avenue for childcare centers to improve their indoor and outdoor air quality by going above and beyond current requirements. Childcare centers that take this step create healthier environments for children and staff to flourish.

What does it cost to access AQMP resources?

Resources are available at no cost. Site evaluations and indoor air quality improvement plans require childcare center staff time. GDI does not currently have funds to support implementing indoor air quality improvements. However, some of the practices that improve indoor air quality cost little or nothing.
